Abstract: The Taylor papers contain Vermont Supreme Court Calendars and Dockets for the years 1919-1925.

Biography: Born in Wheelock, Vermont, July 18, 1863, William Henry Taylor graduated from Hardwick Academy, c. 1882, then Dartmouth College in 1886. He immediately moved back to Hardwick, where he served as the Principal of Hardwick Academy, 1886-1889, then Supervisor of Schools for Caledonia County, 1889-1890. He studied law with Ide and Stafford in St. Johnsbury, Vt., and was admitted to the Vermont bar in 1892. He practiced law in Hardwick in the firm of Taylor and Dutton, 1892-1906, during which he served as States Attorney for Caledonia County, 1894-1898. He served as Representative from Hardwick in the General Assembly of 1900 and Senator for Caledonia County in 1906. He was elected Superior Judge in 1906 and re-elected in 1908 and 1910. He served as County Examiner of teachers for 8 years and as President of Hardwick Village two years. He published a manual of school laws

Taylor married Nettie I. Clark at Hardwick, July 27, 1887. They had four children: Harold F. (3/8/1890), Mildred I (9/3/1892), Florence M. (4/22/1894), Cycle A. (1/31/1901)

He died of pneumonia in March, 1926.
